



Hartnett, Dellinger provide waste management plan support

New Wyoming state regulations require communities to write solid-waste management plans and reassess how they provide services to their residents. Under a contract with the Wyoming office of USDA Rural Development, Midwest Assistance Program Resource Development Advisors Mickey Hartnett and Laura M. Dellinger can provide the support communities need to meet these requirements – at no charge through September.

To connect with communities, Dellinger and Hartnett recently attended and staffed an exhibit at the annual convention of the Wyoming Association of Municipalities held in Jackson. Together they make up MAP's solid-waste team in the western part of the organization's nine-state region. The assistance they can provide includes:

- review and assessment of a community's solid waste system and infrastructure,
- waste audits,
- solid waste management plans, customized public education and outreach, and assistance in establishing or enhancing programs in waste reduction, recycling, composting and vermicomposting (worm compost.)
