Protect the value of your home

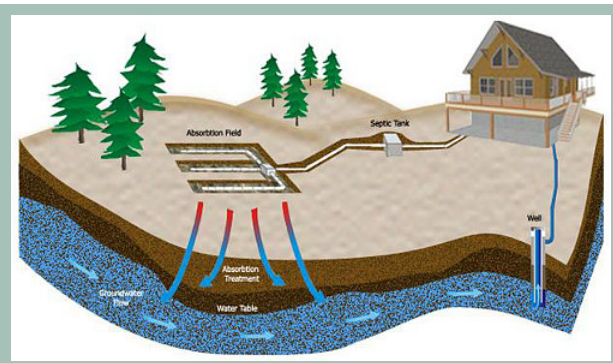
Failed wastewater systems can reduce property value, and prevent property sales.

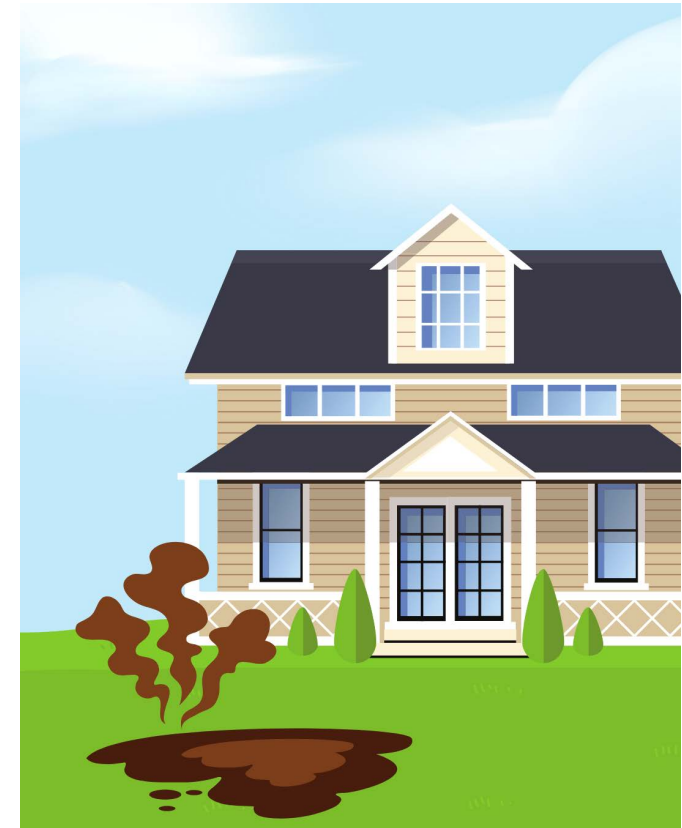
